ABOUT GETM3 PROJECT

Global Entrepreneurial Talent Management 3 - focuses on young talent as a key driver of future development, developed through co-operation of 3 stakeholders: employers (inc MNC & SME's), universities and students/graduates. Despite a widely recognized importance of young talent, its potential remains largely untapped. They are educated and entrepreneurial and yet experience instability in employment. At the same time, employers report skills mismatch and difficulties with attracting, managing and retaining young talent. To tackle this paradoxical situation, an innovative, multi-perspective approach is needed, reinforced by our 15 partner consortium; comprising of a transnational, inter-disciplinary, inter-generational, gender balanced and inter-sectorial research team. The main objective of GETM3 is to improve employability and future global talent management to support economic development by capitalizing on entrepreneurialism as a key characteristic of the young. University of Northumbria at Newcastle, UK is the coordinator of the project.

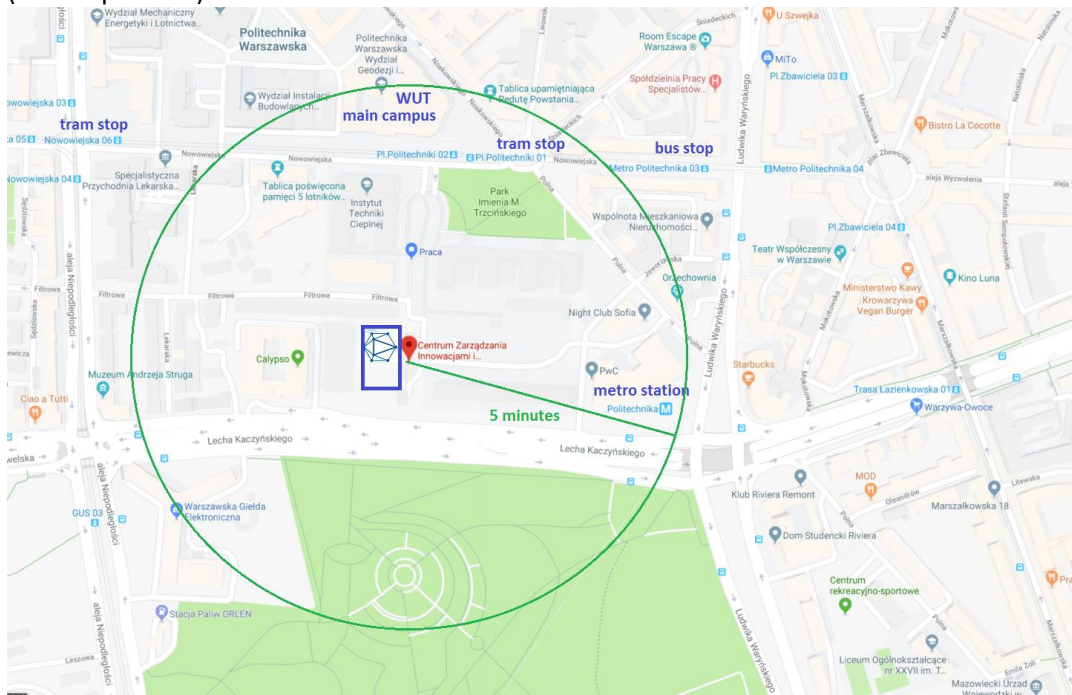

Warsaw can be easily accessed, there are direct flights from almost every major European city (for details please visit [Warsaw Airport homepage](#)). There is also a possibility to travel by train from various European cities.

In Warsaw, there are multiple ways to access the conference venue:

1. TAXI – from centrally located hotels it costs about 8 – 12 Euro.
2. Metro – Currently there are only two lines in Warsaw. To get to WUT, you need to use the first line. WUT is at the station: Politechnika. The Centre for Innovation and Technology Transfer Management is 5 minutes walk from the station.
3. Bus – there are direct buses from the Old Town (180+182) and Central Train Station (direct line 522 to Metro Politechnika bus stop).
4. Trams from the Old Town: 4, 15 (Plac Politechniki tram stop) and from the Central Train Station: 10, 17, 33 (Nowowiejska tram stop).
5. To travel between WUT and Faculty of Management Warsaw University use a direct bus: 174 from Nowowiejska bus stop to Bełdan.
